- Increased confidence in applying for research grants and higher chances of success.


**Conclusion:**

# Research Proposal Format

- **Title of the proposed research project** should be specific, concise and sufficiently descriptive and informative.
- **Summary of Research Project:** A structured summary should contain the following subheadings: Rationale/gaps in existing knowledge, Novelty, Objectives, Methods, and Expected outcome, your good ideas should be convinced
- **R&D Project to cover a priority area /Domain of funding agency**
- **Problem Statement:** State the currently available information to present the problem adequately, focusing on the reported proof of concept
- **Objectives:** Define the objectives clearly and in measurable terms.
- **Methodology:** Include objective-wise work plan under the following sub-headings: a. Study design b. Study site c. Methods d. Sample size e Implementation strategy f. Statistical analysis
- **Budget:** should be appropriate and head wise as per guidelines
- **Timeline:** Quarterly/ monthly basis about research activities
- Whether the study is going to generate new intellectual property
- **Outcomes/achievable targets/Proposed Solution**



## Tips for Writing R&D/ Seminar/Conf/Workshop proposals

1. Initially, for seeking Seminar/ Conf /Workshop grants Rs1 -2 Lakhs National & 3 to 5 Lakhs for International. (as partial grants)
2. Write R&D Proposals with budget below Rs 30 Lakhs and keep equipment cost below 30% of total budget
3. Scientific contributions and publication record of the core team (PI and Co-PIs) Engage a Co-Pis from n Institute of Eminence/R&D Labs/SIRO/ Research Institutions, Faculty Institution/Industry experts will be preferred.
4. Proposals supported by quality publications SCL, Scopus,Wos/patents/copyrights, books/Chapters, consultancy work, NGO-Industrial, Awards Recognition/appreciation/fellowships etc. will be preferred
5. Proposals having Industry partner or have collaboration with other R&D Labs Institutions, will be given preference
6. Proposal submitted by Women faculty members, SC/ST, OBC, PH, Minority etc., will be given
7. MoUs with Industry and Foreign Institutions will be an advantage for joint research projects.
