Preserving the majestic forts of Maharashtra is not merely an effort in historical conservation; it is a commitment to safeguarding the cultural legacy and architectural marvels that define the state. These forts, bearing witness to centuries of history, stand as silent sentinels, each stone echoing tales of valor and resilience. As custodians of our past, the conservation of Maharashtrian forts becomes a responsibility to ensure that future generations can walk amidst the ramparts, connecting with the roots of Maharashtra's rich heritage.

On January 13, 2024, with this in mind, the faculties and students of the Civil Department set out to protect the environment and our priceless historical legacy. Bhorapgad Fort was our choice for the same because of its historical significance. The origin of this fort is said to date back to the 2nd century B.C., the same age as the Thanale Caves and Khadsamble caves nearby. It was then called Bhorapgad (after its presiding deity, Bhoraidevi). In 1436, it was captured by the Bahamani Sultan. In 1657, the Marathas took over and renamed it "Sudhagad"(the sweet one). It was a large fort and was considered by Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj as the capital of his kingdom. He surveyed it, but instead chose Raigad because of its central location.

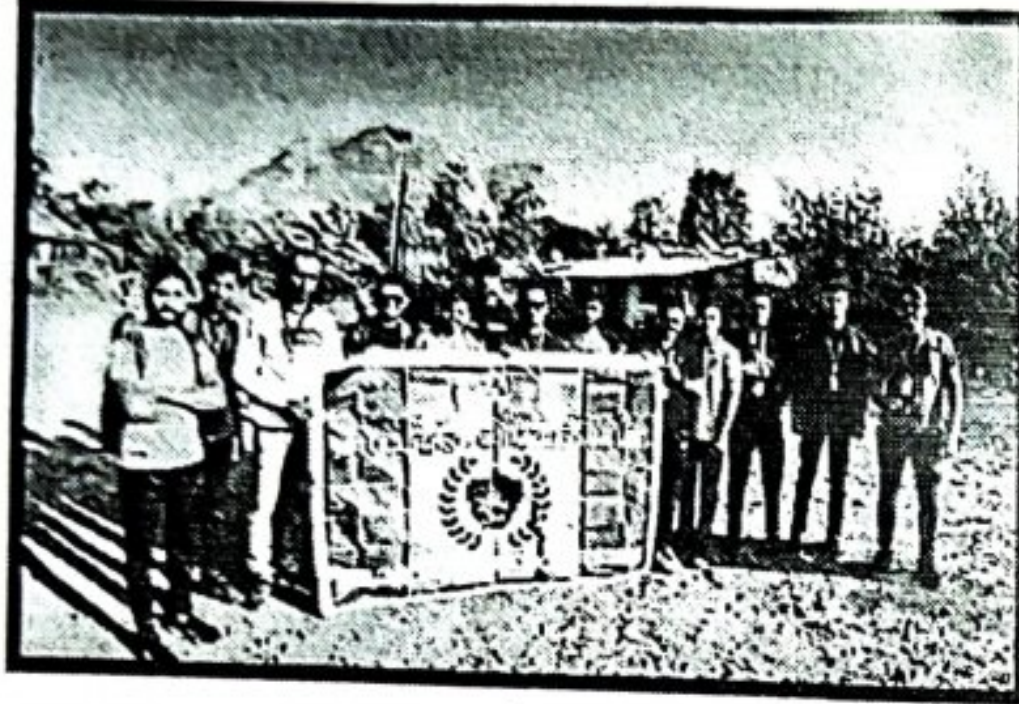
At 9:00 AM, we began our ascent up the fort, and by 12:00 PM, we had reached the summit. The captivating vistas of the entire Ghera Sudhagad made the entire ascent quite visually appealing. As we ascended the fort, everyone was chanting "Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj ki Jay" with great fervor, which lifted our spirits.

After reaching the summit we went out to collect drinking water from the ancient natural filtering water tanks. While enjoying refreshing lime juice, Mr. Santosh Khandagale enlightened everyone with facts and information about the fort and its history.

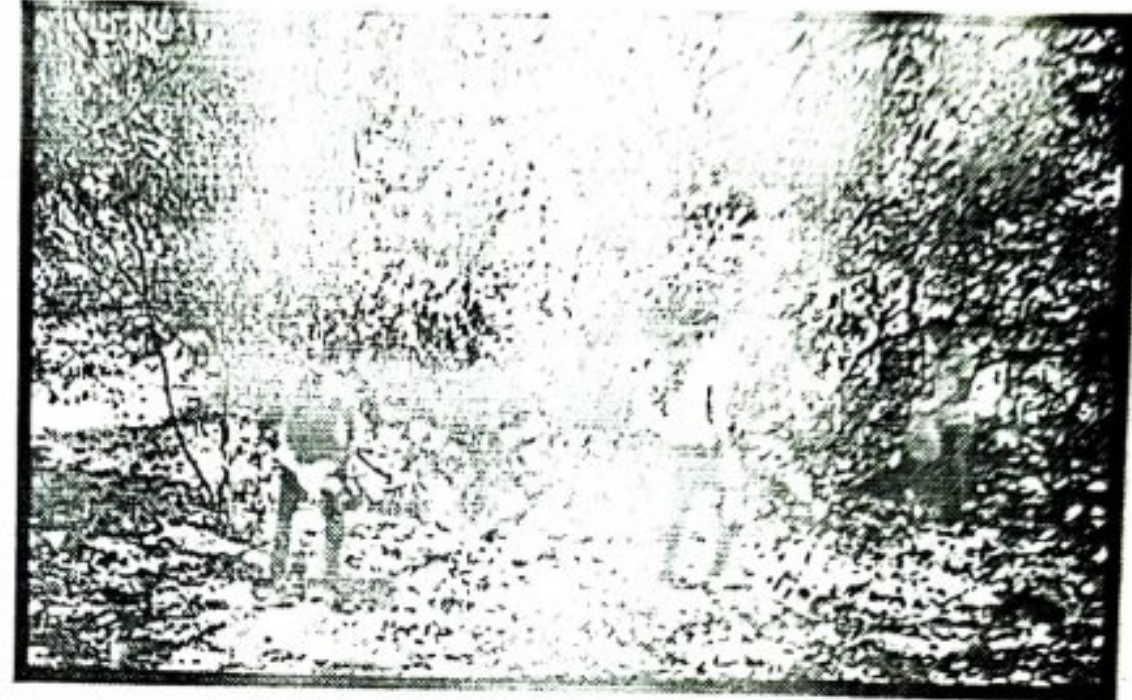

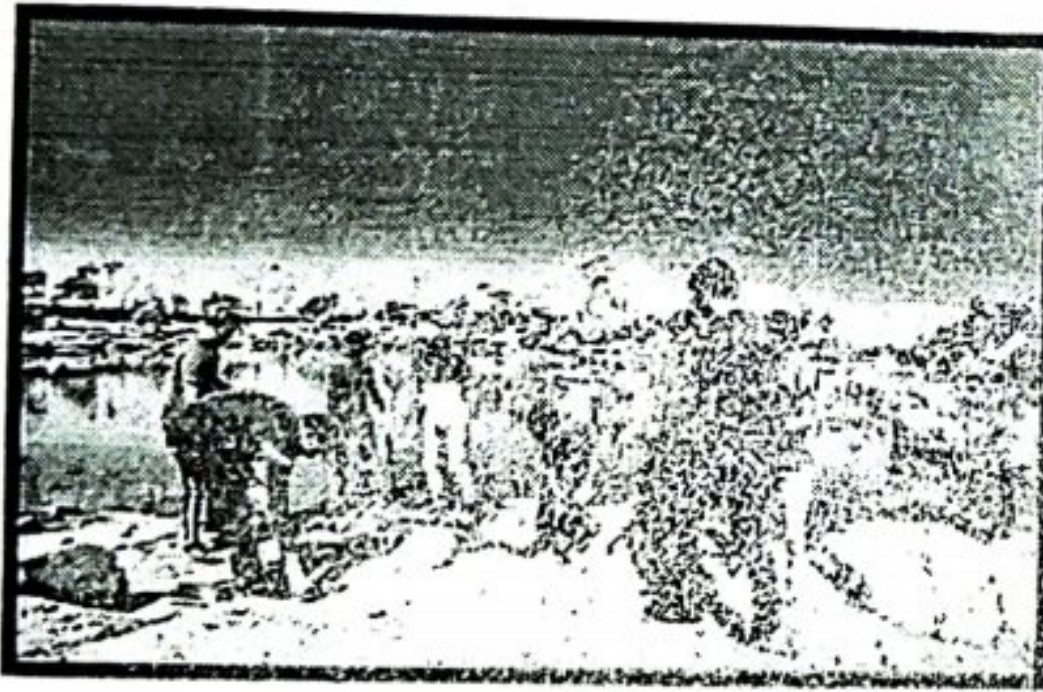

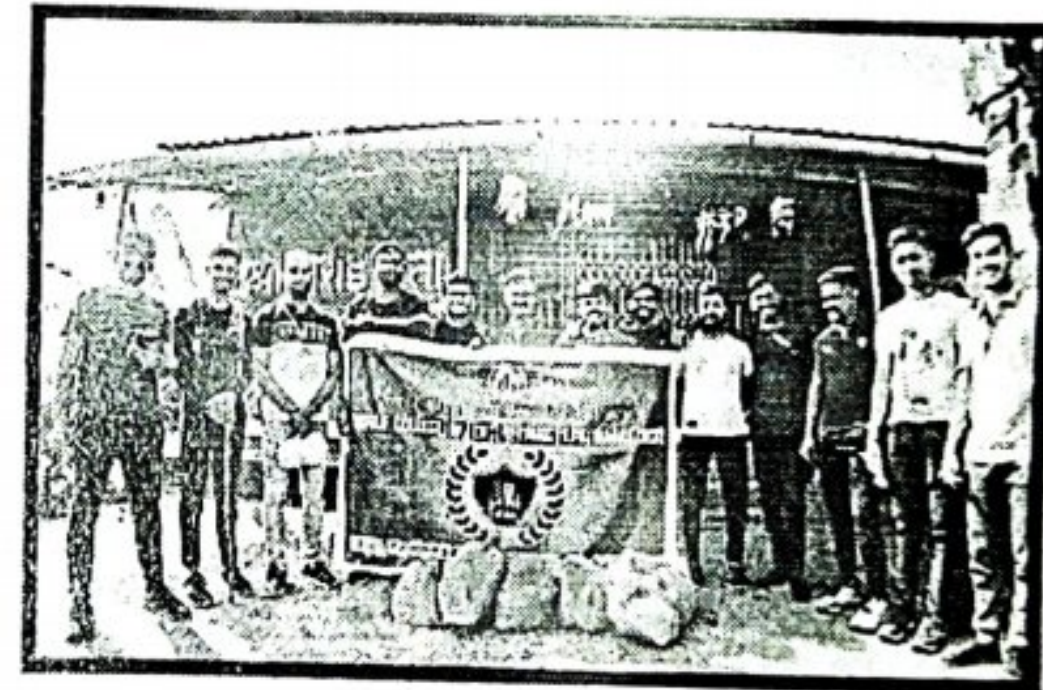
