Overview of Activity

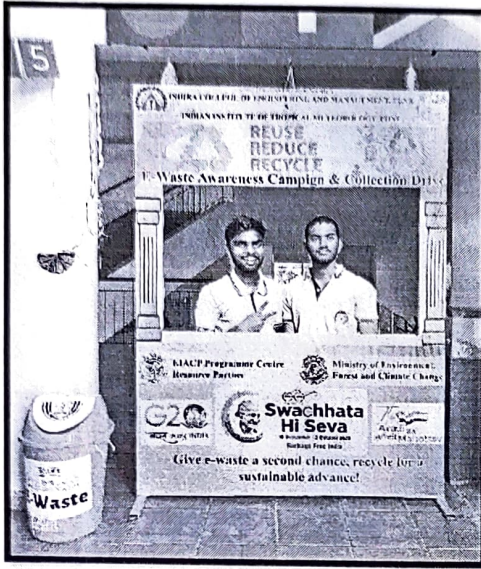
Date of Activity : 3rd October 2023

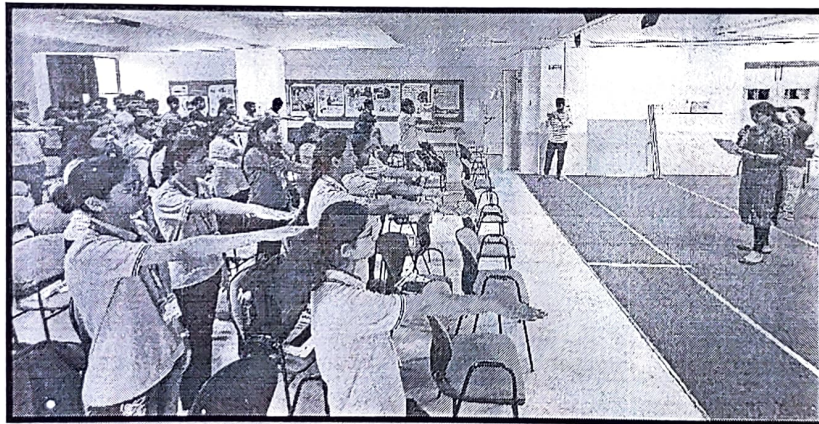

- Foster community participation in environmental conservation.

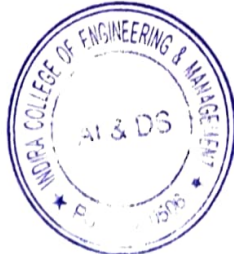
Purpose:

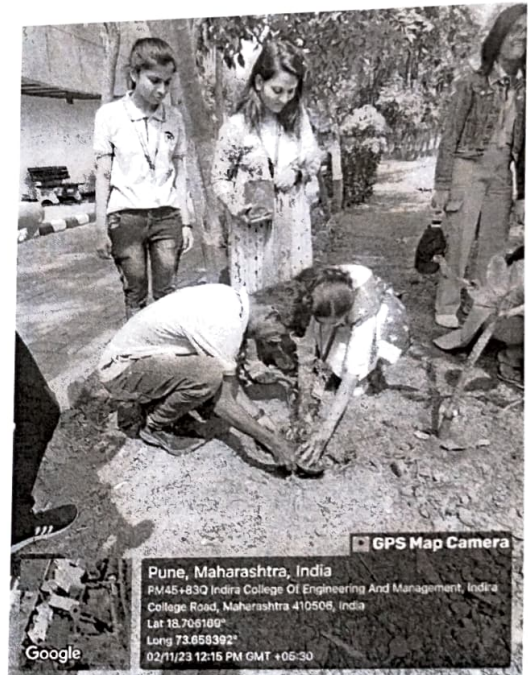
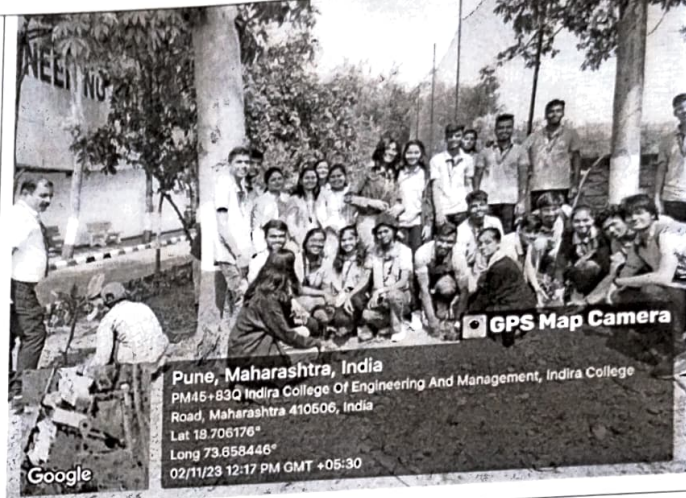
